Right to Information Request 21 November 2016

I refer to your request pursuant to the *Right to Information Act 2009* (RTI Act) received by Hydro Tasmania on 21 November 2016.

I thank you for the extension of time provided for us to collate the information.

I am authorised to make decisions on behalf of Hydro Tasmania in respect of applications for information under the RTI Act.

1. Your Request

Your request was for:

- Emails, letters, reports and briefings relating to the floods which were active in Tasmania over the period 4-7 June 2016.
- Emails, letters, reports and briefings covering flood mitigation issues relating to the floods active in Tasmania over the period 4-7 June 2016.
- Hydro's flood mitigation policies and procedures.
- Emails, letters, reports and briefings created prior to June 4-7 June 2016 that discuss the approaching or potential flooding that was to occur during 4-7 June 2016.
- Emails, letters, reports and briefings created after 4-7 June 2016 that discuss what Hydro did to mitigate the flood that occurred in that period.

Hereafter referred to as "the Request".

2. Determination and Reasons for Determination of the Request

I have undertaken a search of the information held by Hydro Tasmania to locate any records that may be relevant to the Request and have determined as follows.

2.1 Information relevant to the Request

In response to the Request, I have determined that the information provided in the attached to be relevant to the Requests: Appendix A. We have also previously provided a link to the Hydro Tasmania submission to the Flood Enquiry which forms part of this reply to your request.

3. Information withheld

The RTI Act provides that some information in our possession is exempt from release for the reasons stated below.

3.1 Relevant sections of RTI Act

I have assessed the identified Information in accordance with the RTI Act and I regard the following exemptions as being relevant:

(a) Section 35(1) (Internal deliberative information);

- (b) Section 36(1) (Personal information of a person); and
- (c) Section 38(a) (Information relating to business affairs).

As required under Section 33 of the RTI Act, I have considered the Public Interest Test assessment criteria under Schedule 1 to the RTI Act in regards to the information ultimately withheld pursuant to sections 35, 36 or 38 and have determined that it was not in the public interest as a whole to disclose the withheld information.

The reasons for the determination are:

- that the release of the information would not contribute to the debate on the matter
- the information would not inform the request about the reasons for a decision
- the disclosure would prejudice the ability of Hydro Tasmania to obtain similar information in the future
- the disclosure would not provide the contextual information to aid in the understanding of Hydro Tasmania's decisions
- disclosure would promote or harm the interests of an individual or group of individuals
- disclosure may harm the business and/or the financial interests of Hydro Tasmania
