Right to Information Request 3 April 2023

I refer to your request pursuant to the *Right to Information Act 2009* ("RTI Act") made to Hydro Tasmania on 3 April 2023. Thank you for agreeing to the extension of time in respect of this request, with the extension agreed to 6 June 2023. An additional period of 20 working days was also permitted under the RTI Act due to information relating to the business affairs of third parties.

I am authorised to make decisions on behalf of Hydro Tasmania in respect of applications for information under the RTI Act.

1. Your Request

You have requested a copy of the following:

"Since 1 June 2019 and 3 April, 2023 all correspondence between Hydro Tasmania and Tasmanian Irrigation in regards to the Northern Midlands Irrigation Scheme",

(here referred to as the Request).

2. Determination

I have undertaken a search of information held by Hydro Tasmania to locate any records that may be relevant to the Request.

The information that I have determined which can be released to you relevant to the Request is listed in Annexure 1 and copies of those documents are attached together with this letter. A significant volume of the initial returned documents were duplicated and these have now been removed.

I have determined that some of the information relevant to the Request held by Hydro Tasmania is exempt from release in accordance with the RTI Act for the reasons stated below (here referred to as the **Identified Documents**).

I additionally note that some portions of the documents are not responsive or relevant to the Request and have been extracted from the relevant information in accordance with section 18(3) of the RTI Act.

3. Reasons for Determination of Request

The RTI Act provides that certain information is exempt from release in response to an application for assessed disclosure. I have assessed the Identified Documents in accordance with

the RTI Act and have determined that the following exemptions apply to the Identified Documents:

- (a) section 37 (information relating to business affairs of third party);
- (b) section 38 (information relating to business affairs on public authority); and
- (c) section 39 (information obtained in confidence).

These exemptions are additionally subject to the public interest test set out in section 33 of the RTI Act. Partial redactions have also been made to remove mobile telephone numbers, which, in my view, are exempt under section 36 of the RTI Act.

Section 37 (Information relating to business affairs of a third party)

A number of Identified Documents are partially exempted from disclosure on the basis of section 37 of the RTI Act because they contain commercially sensitive information, the public disclosure of which has a high likelihood of causing a third party, Tasmanian Irrigation, a competitive disadvantage. Tasmanian Irrigation is also a 'public authority' under the RTI Act.

Section 37 assessment

Information is exempt information if its disclosure under the RTI Act would disclose information related to business affairs acquired by a public authority (in this case, Hydro Tasmania) from a person or organisation (in this case, Tasmanian Irrigation, who as you know is a state-owned company). Tasmanian Irrigation is in the business of the design and development of irrigation schemes in Tasmania, and in our opinion, the disclosure the Identified Documents (or parts of the Identified Documents) under the RTI Act may expose it to third party competitive disadvantage.

Parts of the Identified Documents include details of the business affairs of Tasmanian Irrigation. This information is not publicly available and, if it were to be disclosed, I am satisfied that:

- (a) it would be likely to grant an unfair competitive advantage to the market competitors of Tasmanian Irrigation (it being uncontentious that there is an active and competitive market for the development of irrigation schemes); and
- (b) this advantage would not exist but for the disclosure.

Accordingly, I have determined that disclosure of some parts of the Identified Documents will be likely to expose the third party in question to competitive disadvantage in the terms contemplated by section 37 RTI Act.

Section 38 (Information relating to business affairs of a public authority) and section 39 (Information obtained in confidence)

Parts of the Identified Documents are wholly or partially exempted from disclosure on the combined basis of sections 38 and 39 of the RTI Act because:

- (a) they contain commercially sensitive information, the public disclosure of which has a high likelihood of causing Hydro Tasmania competitive disadvantage; and/or
- (b) the information was obtained in confidence and disclosure would be reasonably likely to impair Hydro Tasmania's ability to obtain similar information in the future, to the extent that it may prejudice the ability of Hydro Tasmania to negotiate and enter into future transactions.

Section 38 assessment

Information is exempt information for the purposes of the RTI Act if, in the case of a public authority engaged in trade and commerce (in this case, Hydro Tasmania), information is of a

business, commercial or financial nature and its disclosure under the RTI Act would be likely to expose the public authority to competitive disadvantage in the relevant market.

Hydro Tasmania is a public authority engaged in trade and commerce, including as a participant in the National Energy Market. Aspects of the Identified Documents concern the business, commercial and financial affairs of Hydro Tasmania (e.g. modelling data).

Additionally, aspects of the Identified Documents concern the business, commercial and financial affairs of Entura (being, a specialist power, electricity and water services consulting firm).

I am satisfied that, if disclosed, these parts of the Identified Documents are likely to grant Hydro Tasmania's competitors in the National Energy Market an unfair competitive advantage over Hydro Tasmania, which would not exist but for the disclosure of the relevant Identified Documents.

Likewise, I am also satisfied that, if disclosed, parts of the Identified Documents are likely to grant Entura's competitors in the power, electricity and water consulting market an unfair competitive advantage over Entura, which would not exist but for the disclosure of the relevant Identified Documents (e.g. CAD files of design, cost estimates and fees).

Accordingly, I have determined that disclosure of the relevant Identified Documents (or parts of the Identified Documents) would be likely to expose Hydro Tasmania (including Entura) to competitive disadvantage in the terms contemplated by section 38 of the RTI Act.

Section 39 assessment

Information is exempt information if its disclosure under the RTI Act would divulge information communicated by or on behalf of a person to a public authority (in this case, Hydro Tasmania) and the disclosure of the information would be reasonably likely to impair the ability of a public authority to obtain similar information in the future.

This exemption is subject to the qualification in section 39(2) of the RTI Act. However, I have determined that this qualification does not apply to any of the relevant Identified Documents.

Parts of the Identified Documents were supplied to Hydro Tasmania (including Entura) by private organisations on the basis that confidentiality would be kept with respect to it.

Accordingly, I have determined that those parts of the Identified Documents that were communicated in confidence to Hydro Tasmania by the relevant organisation(s) are exempt from disclosure in the terms contemplated by section 39 of the RTI Act.

Public Interest Factors

As noted above, the exemptions in sections 37, 38 and 39 of the RTI Act are subject to the public interest test.

In accordance with section 33 of the RTI Act, I have considered all relevant matters, including those matters set out in Schedule 1 of the RTI Act, particularly those matters specified in (a), (n), (s), (w) and (x).

I consider factors (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), (o) (p) (q) (r) (t) (u) (v) and (y) to be irrelevant.

I have also considered Schedule 2 of the RTI Act and have not taken any of these matters into account in making my determination.

Balancing the factors that weigh against disclosure, I have determined that it is contrary to the public interest to disclose the Identified Documents in accordance with sections 37, 38 and 39 of the RTI Act.

4. Review of Rights

You are entitled under Section 43 of the RTI Act to apply for a review of the decision made under Part 2 of the determination.

Any request for such a review should be made in writing within twenty (20) working days of receiving this letter and addressed to:
